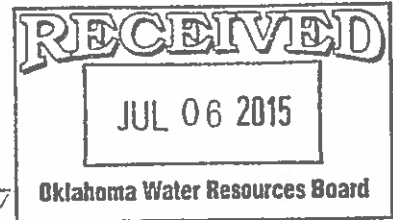


Dear Ms. Cunningham & Mr. Mackey,

Please let this letter serve as a status report and for compliance purposes with 82 O.S. §1020.2(F)(1). Arbuckle Aggregates LLC (AA) submitted a mine permit application to the Oklahoma Department of Mines (ODM) on May 17, 2010, and is still in the administrative process to obtain its permit, no mining permit has been issued. According to §1020.2(C)(2), AA is considered an exempt mine. Once the mining permit is issued, AA will report quarterly and annually to the OWRB on the mining status. This will be done in accordance with the §1020.2(F)(1). If the mine permit is issued between reporting periods, AA will contact the OWRB prior to mining.

For your records, AA did not produce any mine products or accumulate any pit water during the first quarter.
